The Offering for the Poor collected today is designated to help the needy in the church.

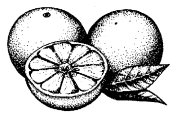
Church Officers (Second Reading & Vote) – the Church Board has voted to recommend to the church to extend the current officers for another year.
