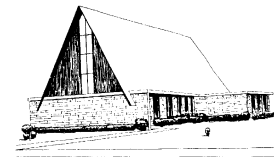

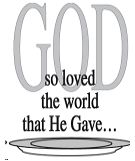
RED CROSS BLOOD DRIVE

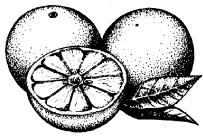
