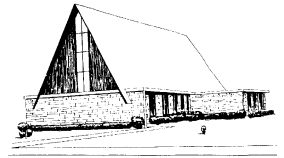

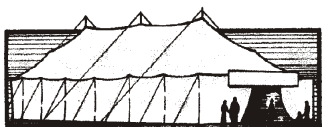
Please pray for those who are seeking to follow Jesus all the way. Many are continuing with Bible studies.

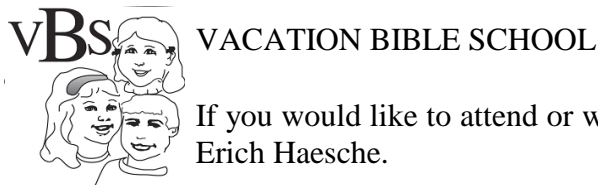
### CHURCH BUSINESS MEETING

### FELLOWSHIP LUNCHEONS



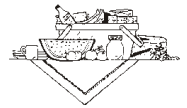

### GRADUATES



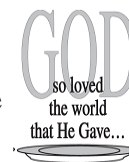
