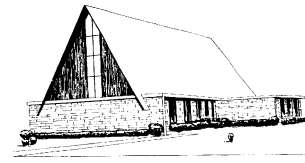

CREATION SERIES

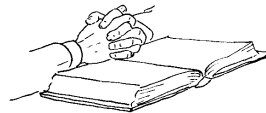
