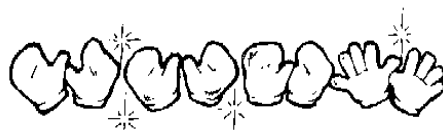

FROM THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Greetings, Dear Friends:

Where does your righteousness come from – Your fitness for heaven? Is it something you are exercising your will with all your might to gain through doing good works and overcoming your bad habits, or does the Lord want us to embrace another method of salvation? In my own experience, I've learned that the times I am defeated the most in my struggle against my sinful self is when I become so focused upon "overcoming" my bad tendencies that I forget that the real source of anything good in me is God and God alone.

I think it's safe to say that we are all like that. A prophet named Jeremiah wrote that "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: Who can know it?" (Jeremiah 17:9). You and I may be getting along pretty well, no major sins in our life, and we're feeling pretty sure of ourselves, that we're "good" people, and that somehow God owes it to us to take us to heaven when Jesus comes. Then, bam!! We're hit with a major temptation that we succumb to, and now we feel guilty, ashamed, frightened of God's judgment. How glad we are that Jesus died so that God can forgive us of our sins (1 John 1:9), but, oh how we wish we could just get victory over every sin in our lives. And we take our eyes off Jesus, and we fix our gaze on our moral performance, promising ourselves and God that "we'll do better." Ultimately,

we find ourselves caught in a cycle of sin and repent, sin and repent, until many get discouraged to the point of giving up and falling away from Christ completely.

What is the real problem? May I suggest that the human tendency many of us fall for is to rely too heavily upon a "works" based righteousness, as opposed to a grace-based righteousness to complete God's work in us and prepare us for heaven. My own experience, again, is that when I understand and embrace the Biblical teaching that not only salvation at the second coming, but also salvation from sin here and now, is a gift from God, purchased at the cross of Calvary, administered by the Holy Spirit, and received by humble faith, then I, in increasing measure, receive the victory over self and sin that God wants me to have, and with this victory comes the joy of the Lord. Paul reminds us, in 1 Corinthians 1:30, that "of Him (God) are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption." It's all about keeping our focus on Jesus. It's all about entrusting to Him our salvation and hope. Look to Jesus and away from yourself and you cannot fail to be saved. May God bless you.

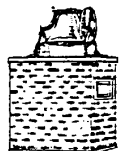


to touch lives and change hearts.

Please join us each Sabbath morning. Song service begins at 9:20. Classes are provided for adults and children.



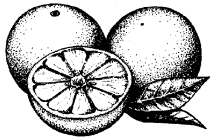
Mission DVDs are shown the last Sabbath of each month. This quarter they are from the South Pacific Division.
