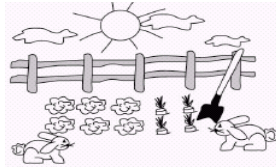

FROM THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Have you received God's call to service? Have you been listening for this call? There's a beautiful story in the Bible about a young boy named Samuel who heard and followed God's call to prophesy to the people.

Samuel, you may know, was a lad dedicated to the Lord by his mother because of a pledge she had made prior to his birth that, if God would bless her with a child, she would give him up to serve the Lord in the temple when the boy came of age. So now we have the boy Samuel sleeping on the floor of the tabernacle when he hears, not once, but three times, a voice from God. Samuel goes the first two times to the high priest, Eli, thinking that the old man was calling him. The third time the boy, following Eli's instructions, simply responds to the voice in the words, "Speak, Lord, your servant heareth." So it was that the boy Samuel received his calling by God to be a witness for Him.

Well, you say, that's the story of Samuel. And it's a beautiful story, but what's the message in it for me?

The message is this: When we choose to follow Christ, to become His disciple, to join His church, which is His body, then we are really answering His call to serve in much the same way that Samuel was called to serve. Think for a moment, would you, about the meaning of the word "church." I know in our westernized culture we tend to think of "church" as a building, or an organized institution. The original Greek word for "church" is "ecclesia," which means a people "called out." We are "called out" to belong to the body of God's witnessing people. We are called – and qualified by His Spirit – to duplicate the ministry of love, service, and proclamation that Jesus Christ performed when He walked the earth.

So, that is what the example of young Samuel teaches us. Do we truly believe that we are called to live out Christ's ministry in the world? Do we listen for God's voice to lead us into the kinds of loving service He wants us to do in His name? May God bless us all as we answer His call to ministry, and may our response always be, "Speak, Lord, for Your servant heareth."

WORSHIP SERVICE

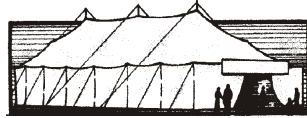
Sabbath, June 1, our sermon will be via DVD, by Elder Ted Wilson, President of the General Conference.

Dear Elmira Friends:

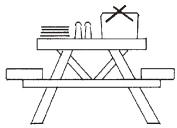
