FROM THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Greetings Friends,

For a long time I have been fascinated with the study of God, religion, and how they interface with the vast universe we inhabit.



Astronomers are continually discovering more and more objects in space that are breath-taking in their beauty. The size of the universe, the number of galaxies, the intricate workings of the laws of nature that keep it all working. It adds a rich new meaning to that straight forward Bible verse that declares, "In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth." (Genesis 1:1)

Visualize with me, for a moment, a scene out of the Old Testament that still could describe some regions of the Middle East today. The scene is that of a shepherd boy, tending the flock under his care, sitting under the starry heavens strumming on his harp and creating psalms of praise to the God of his fathers. As his mind works upon the mystery of the bright hosts above him, the Spirit of God gives him these words:




"The heavens declare the glory of God, and the firmament shows His handiwork. Day unto day utters speech, and night unto night reveals knowledge." (Psalm 19:1,2)

With these words, our psalmist, believed to be David, calls our attention to the first great evidence of God's existence – the created universe. For much of his life,

as long as he reserved for himself that child-like sense of wonder at God's handiwork, David lived his life in trust in God as his Friend, his Deliverer, his Mighty Rock and Fortress. It was when David lost that sense of wonder that he found himself in trouble.

Besides the truth of God's creation, the psalmist goes on in the 19th Psalm to call our attention to God's revelation to us in the written Word. Psalm 19:7 states:

"The law of the Lord is perfect, converting the soul. The testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple."



So David first reminds us that it is God Who has designed and created this incredible universe we inhabit, and it is God Who now speaks to us through the revelations of the Holy Bible. Through prophecy, through His instructions to His covenant people, and, above all, through the life, death, and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ, it is revealed to us that God, our God, the Creator of this vast and wonderful universe, is the One Who loves us enough to involve Himself in our dilemma, the dilemma brought on by sin. He is the God Who is big enough, and loving enough, to care for us in every circumstance. May we learn to trust Him deeper each day, and may our walk with Him be a rich revealing of His greatness and character.

THE CHILDREN'S OFFERING


The children's offering taken during the worship service each Sabbath sponsors our children at Camp Cherokee next summer.



2014 North American Division Mission Investment Projects

Lake Union Conference Mission Investment Projects

1. Inner city projects are to go to the various schools and offer spiritual programs, such as Vacation Bible School (FLAG camp), and to train leaders to assist the impoverished. These programs create and foster friendships and evangelistic connections within the community.
2. The project at the Burns Seventh-day Adventist Church, Detroit, Michigan, is primarily focused on providing a soup kitchen, mentoring programs for high-risk teens, and conducting Revelation and Eternity Prophecy seminars. Other areas of emphasis are self-development seminars, including drugs, alcohol, finances, divorce, and domestic violence awareness. Also included are tending to two community greenhouses and a community garden.

Columbia Union Mission Investment Project

SOULS EAST: This initiative will develop leadership that will labor for the conversion of souls, as Jesus commissioned us. One objective is to inspire and empower churches each year to develop a culture of evangelism. This will empower youth and young adults to be engaged in the mission of the church. SOULS East will recruit, train, mentor, and send out teams of students to work with local churches in the cycle of evangelism through Bible work, literature ministry, and health ministry. These activities will take place throughout the Columbia Union in selected areas and churches and will be in partnership with SOULS West, <http://soulswest.org/>.
