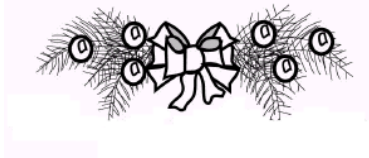
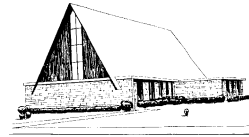

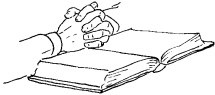

### BIBLE STUDY



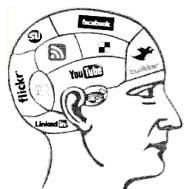
Bible Study is held Tuesday evenings, 6:30 p.m. at the church.

## BAPTISM

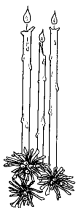

## FELLOWSHIP LUNCHEONS

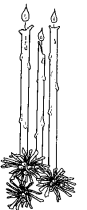

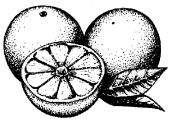
