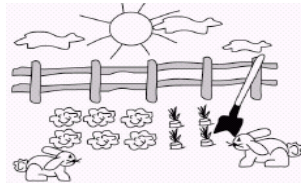

FROM THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Robert Robinson was a troubled young man. His dad died at a young age. To make matters worse, you could always find young Robert hanging around the wrong crowd, getting into trouble, and disregarding authority. Although he had a bad temper and neglect toward his Heavenly Father, God had His eyes on young Robert. It was not long before God stepped into Robert's tangled life and lifted him up from the pit of despair. One afternoon Robert's life was changed for the better. He decided to attend a meeting that was held by the Methodist preacher George Whitefield. Robert was convicted and by the age of 20 years old he gave his life to God. He later wrote the hymn that is found in our Hymnal entitled "Come Thou Fount Of Every Blessing." As the last stanza says, "Prone to wander, Lord, I feel it, Prone to leave the God I love." It wasn't long before Robert Robinson's hymn came true in his very own life. Robert left his newfound faith. How could this happen to a man such as this; a man who gave his life to God? Well, the very words of Paul tell us in Hebrews 2:1 "Therefore

we must give the more earnest heed to the things we have heard, lest we *drift away*." (Italics added). There is no effort to drifting away; we just simply float as if in a hot air balloon traveling by the gentle breeze of the wind, in which the movements are hardly noticed. Then, once we have drifted so easily down this pathway to destruction, we look back at our experience and say to ourselves, "How did we ever get here?" In order not to drift we must give the most earnest heed to the things we have heard. Keep the things



you learned about Christ in your heart and constantly go over them, constantly think about them. We must pay attention to these things! We must value the words of the Bible, and value Jesus for who He is every single hour of every single day for the rest of our lives. Wake up and listen to the words of the Lord speaking to your heart. Let it change you and mold you into the man/woman that He would have you to be.

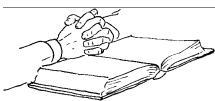
