

SPIRITUAL SPOT

“Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh His name in vain.” Exodus 20:7.

The third commandment is possibly the most frequently broken of God’s Ten Commandments. Millions every day utter His name as a swear word. In fact one woman, when becoming a Christian, had difficulty getting used to saying the name *Jesus Christ*, because her father had so often cursed the Savior’s name.

But taking the Lord’s name in vain is not just uttering His name as a swear word. It means to speak His name “in an irreverent or blasphemous manner.”¹ Noah Webster said, “To take the name of God in vain, to use the name of God with levity or profaneness.”² *Levity* refers to using His name in a light, careless, or frivolous manner. Time and again jokes are made about our Creator, which is also irreverent and disrespectful to a holy God.

In truth we do not know how holy God is. Paul tells that God is “dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see.” 1 Timothy 6:16. And what do the angels do when they speak His name? “...Each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly. And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of His glory.” Isaiah 6:2, 3. They cover their faces.

How much more should we humans have respect for the name of the Lord? Let us remember the words of the psalmist, and hold our Creator in reverence and awe. “He sent redemption unto His people: He hath commanded His covenant for ever: holy and reverend is His name.” Psalm 111:9.
