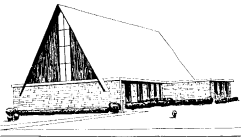

EMERGENCY FIRST RESPONSE CLASS

Everyone should know what to do in a medical emergency situation.

Sunday, March 3, Brittany Miller presented a class on Emergency First Response in the church Fellowship Hall. This was a part of her course work as she completes her Masters Degree in Nursing. This class covered how to use the AED and when and how to perform CPR. Mannequins were available for demonstration and practice. Another area covered was recognizing and treating for hypoglycemia. Fall victims were also discussed. Brittany presented information via Audio Visual material, discussing symptoms and actions to take when someone is in need of medical intervention.

Plans are for an Emergency First Response Team at the church to maintain our readiness to be available when help needed, as well as annual refresher classes.

We very much appreciate Brittany’s efforts in bringing us this training.

LITERATURE EVANGELISTS

RECIPE CORNER

Hummus

1 16 oz can of chickpeas (garbanzo beans)
1/4 cup liquid from can of chickpeas
3-5 tablespoons lemon juice (depending on taste)
1 1/2 tablespoons tahini

2 cloves garlic, crushed
1/2 teaspoon salt
2 tablespoons olive oil



Drain chickpeas and set aside liquid from can.

Combine remaining ingredients in blender. Add 1/4 cup of liquid from chickpeas. Blend for 3-5 minutes on low until thoroughly mixed and very smooth. Good with raw vegetables such as: broccoli, cauliflower, carrots, peppers, or with tortilla chips or whole wheat crackers. Cooked dry garbanzo beans can be substituted for the canned beans.
