RED CROSS BLOOD DRIVE

Did you know:

1. Each year, the American Red Cross responds to more than 70,000 disasters, both natural and man-made.
2. Every 2 seconds someone in the United States needs blood.
3. One donation can help save the lives of up to 3 people.
4. Approximately 41,000 units of blood are used each day in the United States.
5. One out of every three people will need donated blood in their lifetime.
6. One pint of blood can save up to three lives.

Our next scheduled drive is Tuesday, February 4, 1:30 – 6:30 p.m. in the church fellowship hall. Donation Types: Double Red Cell and Whole Blood. Please consider making a donation. Future dates for our drives this year are: April 14, and June 9, 2020.

Since we began blood drives at our church July 14, 2005, 694 units have been collected, enough to potentially help 2082 people.

RECIPE CORNER

Borscht (Beet Soup)

1 stalk celery, chopped
1-2 carrots, sliced
1 medium onion
1 garlic clove, minced
1 cup shredded cabbage
1-2 cups shredded beets

1 quart canned tomatoes, chopped
2-3 potatoes, peeled and cubed
1/4 cup fresh or canned mushrooms
salt to taste
2 Tbsp. vegan margarine or olive oil



Cook in a little water the celery, carrots, onion, garlic, cabbage, and beets. When vegetables are beginning to soften, add tomatoes, potatoes, mushrooms, salt and margarine or oil. Cook until done. Works well in a crock pot.
